- Handle the laboratory items as well as library books with utmost care.

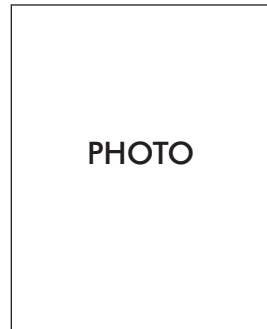
Guidelines to the parents

- Parents should co-operate with the school in its attempt to help your children's progress by paying attention to punctuality, regularity and discipline. As joint educators, parents should instill in their child respect and obedience to the school rules and regulations
- Parents are requested to go through the school diary regularly and sign the teacher's remarks, if any. They must ensure that their child brings the School Diary to the school every day.
- You can meet the principal and teachers during the visiting hours.
- School believes in direct interaction with parents, for matters related to academic performance/ behavioural issues and any other administrative requirements of child to prevent any misunderstanding.
- Be open to listening and considering the teacher's opinion regarding your child. Encourage your child to speak in English at home and provide him/her ambience to improve spoken English.
- PTMs should be regularly attended to discuss the performance and progress of the child.
- Children must be encouraged to do their homework by themselves. It is important that children should develop a habit of working on their own. However, parental supervision is important.
- Taking leave during working days is strongly discouraged. The school will expect these students to be at par with the class in every way and that will have to parents. be ensured by the parents.
- If a child is found unwell while at school or gets injured while playing, then school will inform parents immediately and will be allowed to collect their child from school for further course of action.
- Mobile culture should not be encouraged during school life. Experience conveys that there is more harm than good due to mobile addiction. It is a device which distracts most of the children from their studies.
- Please be sure to inform the school if there is any change in your address, designation or telephone number.
- Parents are requested to support and co-operate with the school by paying fee on time and behave modestly to all staff.

Rules of Transportation

- Students are advised to wish and respect the driver and the caretaker.
- When the bus is in motion, students must not move around in the bus and should not peep or put their hands out, through the window.
- The driver must not be distracted for any reason.
- The students must ensure that the aisle of the bus is clear; school bags and other belongings are placed correctly.
- A student who avail the school bus should arrive at the bus stop at least 10 minutes before the time schedule.

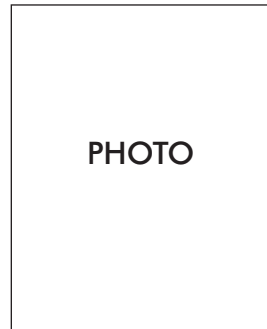

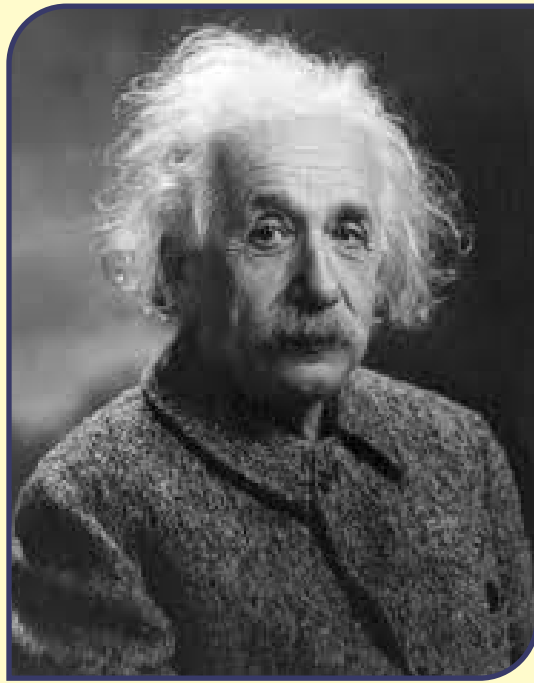
Courage and Resilience

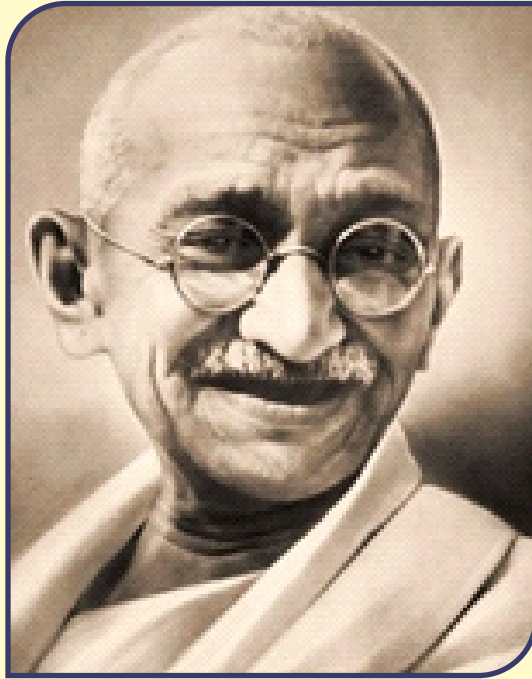
Charisma and confidence

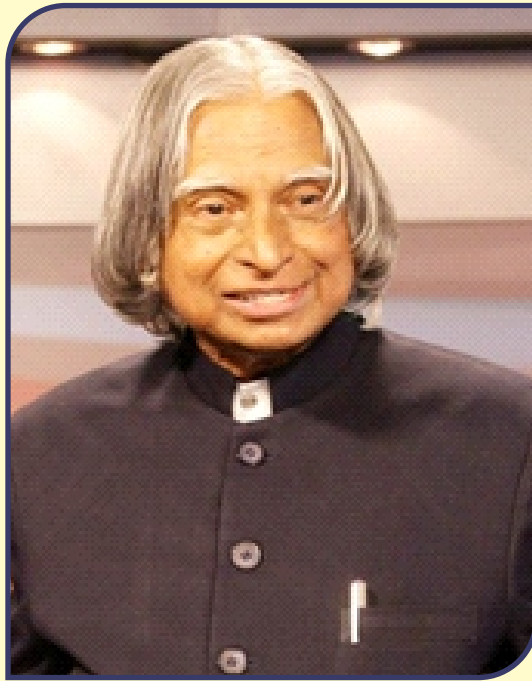
Ambition and Fortitude
